Dear Parents/Guardians:

As we approach the final stages of construction on the PIT, there are a few jobs to complete in the next week or so that we would like to make you aware of.

Today contractors are working on core drilling for posts in the concrete. On Friday they will be installing the metal posts, and on Saturday they will be paving. We've been told that this is a difficult and complicated process. Although it does not look like we will have +5 degree weather, the contractors will be using a different process that can withstand colder temperatures. This process requires a lot of equipment and our school parking lot will be needed to hold all of this equipment. We are asking you, therefore, not to park in our parking lot this weekend. The construction crew will require the entire lot. **If there is a car that is blocking access for the paving equipment, they will tow the car.** As a courtesy, please share this info with any of your neighbours who may be used to parking their car in our school lot on weekends.

Sometime next week, the fencing should be completely installed. On Tuesday next week the terra-seeding should take place. This area will be fenced off until the spring, but the asphalt sections should be open for student use. Finally, sometime next week the City of Toronto catchment work should start as well.

All of this work is entirely dependent on weather conditions and the temperature, but we hope that with the work continuing through the weekend, we can have the PIT open before the Winter Holiday Break.
